Chung Yuan University Network Usage Regulations

Amended at the Computer Resource Committee on January 12, 2022

The purpose of establishing the campus network at Chung Yuan University is to support research and teaching activities of faculty and students, create a platform for sharing resources within and outside the campus, and provide opportunities for collaboration. This regulation outlines the rules for the use of the Chung Yuan University network. When transmitting data across other networks, users are still required to comply with the management regulations of those networks.

The regulations for the use of the Chung Yuan University network are as follows:

- 1. Users must comply with the relevant management regulations of the Ministry of Education and the Taiwan Academic Network, as well as the "Chung Yuan University Campus Computer and Network Resource Management Regulations."
- 2. Posting information that is inconsistent with the purpose of the university campus network is prohibited.
- 3. Transmission of information that is threatening, obscene, offensive, or violates intellectual property rights and personal data protection laws is prohibited.
- 4. To conserve network bandwidth, bulk transmission of information without the cooperation and permission of relevant backbone network nodes is prohibited.
- 5. Non-teaching and non-research network activities may be subject to restrictions imposed by the Computer Center (hereinafter referred to as the "Center").
- 6. To avoid interfering with teaching and research, unauthorized installation of servers is prohibited.
- 7. The total amount of network communication (outgoing and incoming traffic) for each computer (IP) per day is limited as follows: Students: not exceeding 20GB bytes, Faculty and staff: not exceeding 30GB bytes, Servers: not exceeding 50GB bytes. Those with special requirements can submit a request through the Computer Center's processing system. If the limit is exceeded, the Center may disconnect the network connection. Repeat violations will result in the Center sending email notifications to the users and their respective supervisors, urging them to exercise restraint in usage. Supervisors are required to respond to the Center, informing them of the improvement measures taken.
- 8. Servers (such as WWW sites, FTP sites, BBS sites) set up by various units shall comply with the "Chung Yuan University Campus Computer and Network Resource Management Regulations."
- 9. If a server on the campus network is found to be involved in the transmission or retrieval of inappropriat e network information (such as spam, network viruses, network attacks, etc.), the Center may terminate the campus network connection of that server and announce it on relevant websites.
- 10. This regulation has been approved at the meeting of the Computer Resource Committee and will be announced by the President. Any revisions will follow the same procedure.
